

Time Attack

The newest craze on the Japanese tuning scene is time attack competitions and CSCS is proud to be hosting the first time attack series in Canada. Time Attack events originated in Japan by various media outlets, so that tuning shops could show off their newest products and purpose built vehicles. CSCS time attack competitions are strategically set up to allow proper classes for stock vehicles all the way up to 700whp track monsters. Upon registering for the time attack competition drivers are placed into one of our 9 classes based on their vehicle and modifications. Refer to the 2007 CSCS Time Attack Rulebook for vehicle classification.

CSCS time attack competitions are exclusively held at Toronto Motorsports Park (TMP, Cayuga) on their 3km road course.

Each driver will receive open lapping for the morning and greater part of the afternoon giving them a chance to fine tune their vehicles and learn the track layout. CSCS will be setup to accommodate everyone from beginners (instructors available) to full blown track cars. These laps are not taken into consideration for the actual competition. Drivers will then get 3 laps (1 warm up, 3 timed, and 1 cool down) which the driver will attempt to set the fastest time.

After each event class winners will receive a trophy and prizes in each of our 9 classes. Each driver regardless of finishing position will also earn points towards the CSCS Time Attack Championship.
